At the end of each program cycle, MARNmentors culminates in an exhibition that highlights the professional and personal developments and collaborations between our talented mentors and mentees.

2015 MARN Mentor /Mentee Exhibition opens Saturday, January 9, 2016, 5 – 10 p.m. at Var Gallery & Studios in historic Walker's Point (643 S. 2nd Street). The exhibition concludes with a closing reception on Saturday, January 23, 2016, 5 – 10 p.m.
